

Welcome back to in-person worship at Bethel!

As we return to worship in the sanctuary, there are a few things you should know.

- Masks should be worn at all times while in the church, except
- while taking communion.
- Please follow social distancing guidelines, maintaining a six-foot distance between you and fellow congregants outside of your household.
- Video cameras are rolling for at least 20 minutes prior to the service and until the service is over.
- If needed, please use the bathroom in the hallway leading to the sanctuary.
- Our worship team will be singing at the front of the church to pre-recorded music provided by James Pick. In accordance with Washington State requirements for religious organizations, congregants are asked not to sing aloud in the church.
- Individual communion cups and wafers are available to pick up from a table as you are
 checked in at the welcome desk. We will remain in our pews during communion. First
 peel the clear plastic sleeve to receive communion wafer, and then pull up on the purple
 tab to access the grape juice. Please return the empty cup to the small trash tray located
 on your pew. The ushers will gather them after everyone has been dismissed from the
 sanctuary.
- The usher will dismiss you one pew at a time staring from the back of the sanctuary. entrance/exit (ROCKSOLID access) to the church at the back of the sanctuary.
- Your offering can be placed in the plate by the door as you exit the church.
- The church will be sanitized by designated ushers, so please exit the building when you are excused by the usher.
