Pastor's Page

This summer the three boards of Bethel's Church Council met to wonder and dream about how God might be calling our congregation to engage in ministry together. Each board brought up good questions and ideas. Please read the Council report to see which topics rose to the top for immediate, short-term and long-term action. (See page 6)

I shared in a recent sermon about the values that our priorities reflected. These shouldn't come as a surprise to many of our Bethel members. They echo what we talked about last summer when I met with you in small groups to learn more about our congregation. Here is what we affirmed about who we are:

#### **VALUES OF BETHEL LUTHERAN CHURCH**

We value encouraging and supporting the well-being of children and young people.

We value being connected to our community.

We value being in loving, supportive relationships.

All of these values are founded upon the love of God we have experienced through Jesus Christ. Bethel Lutheran Church values being a place and a community where God's love is shared.

This month individuals and families will have an opportunity to connect with one or more ministries that align with the gifts and experiences of each person. I am sure that all of us extend the love of God in many ways through various aspects of daily life. Participating in more intentional ministry in the life of the church is another way we can do that. And through these activities we are also building community with one another and with the world we have been sent to serve and love.

One of the gifts of the pandemic shutdown was that by stopping much of what we used to do, we are given the opportunity to evaluate whether to pick something up again or not, and if we do, to determine whether we might do that old thing in a new way. Having one Sunday worship service rather than two is one of the things that is similar but different than before March 2020.

We have been asked by many members when Wednesday evening activities will resume. Our Deacons and Board of Education are working now to make decisions about what might be similar and what might be different. Please be patient as we make those plans, with the hope of starting in October.

In the meantime, we invite you to pay attention to the ways you can minister to and with our young people, reach out to our neighboring community, and form deeper friendships within the life of Bethel and with those who share in ministry with us.

### Pastor Lynne Ogren presents "Journey to the Holy Land"

Brush Prairie, Washington – Bethel Lutheran Church will present "Journey to the Holy Land" at 12919 NE 159<sup>th</sup> Street, Brush Prairie, on Sunday, September 18, at 2 p.m., featuring its pastor, the Rev. Lynne M. Ogren.

Pastor Lynne Ogren, installed as Bethel's pastor on July 18, 2021, has brought light, love and God's eternal promise to her teaching and sermons. In that same vein, she is excited about sharing her June 2022 trip to the Holy Land through photos and unique "tastes" of traditional Israeli foods that will transport attendees to the faraway land. The community is invited to join Bethel members as they settle in to hear Pastor Lynne tell of her long-awaited journey to walk where Jesus walked.

Pastor Lynne shared, "Friends and colleagues have been encouraging me to find a way to get to the Holy Land sooner than later and I am so glad this opportunity came up! I have long treasured the words of Jesus and the ancient Hebrew writings, but they take on a whole new meaning when we notice the settings where they were spoken. I am excited to share a taste of what our group experienced this summer."

Families are invited to this no-cost event. A free-will offering will be collected that night to support Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp, the organization that hosted the trip.

Bethel Lutheran Church, which was formed with only 32 members in 1917 as a Norwegian Lutheran congregation, is located on its original site just northeast of Brush Prairie. It is the home of Rocksolid Community Teen Center, which provides a safe haven at the end of the school day for 5<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students from the Battle Ground and Hockinson School Districts.

### **Council Meeting Highlights - August 2022**

- Sandy Egan was unanimously confirmed to fill the vacancy on the Board of Deacons. Candi Ehrich will be the VP for the Board of Deacons.
- Council Boards each met separately with Pastor Lynne over the last few months to participate in small group discernment sessions. After reviewing the summary from each board meeting, the council agreed that our Bethel values are embodied in supporting and developing: children and youth, community connections and relationships.
- Though there were many good ideas and visions shared for Bethel, the council has prioritized the following three:
- Short-term vision planning: Revive the Wednesday evening gatherings, possibly to include food, choir and / or education time.
- Mid-range vision planning: Explore youth ministry staffing plan.
- Longer range vision planning: Form a sanctuary task force to identify and propose a change to the worship space.
