A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR LYNNE...

This month you are invited to attend one of our Picnics with Pastor! I will be at three different parks the last three Wednesdays of the month to visit with Bethel folks. I have two main questions for discussion, so I thought you might like to think about them ahead of time.

His favorite question to ask the staff and the patients is "How can I help?" While he often solves some of their problems, he also discovers that people tend know what they need to help them do their jobs better or to improve their lives. The director's role is simply to say, "Yes!"

You know this congregation as well or better than I do. What do we need to do or to become to be faithful to the ministry to which God has called us? I'll guess that there are plenty of interesting and creative ideas just waiting to be voiced. My role is to help you realize these dreams that God has placed on your hearts.

Come join me for some good conversation as we enjoy the beauty of God's creation! I can't wait to hear what inspiration you have to share for our life and ministry together!




SOUTHWEST WA SYNOD NEWS Path for Strengthening Active Lay Ministry (PSALM)

Application Process Open!

Rooted in Lutheran theological tradition and in the context of the Pacific Northwest, PSALM is a community of learners and leaders engaged in a process of conversation, reading, prayer and practice with the intention of growing in faith, clarity of mission, and skills for ministry. The PSLAM cohorts meet for 4 terms over two years in October and March at Seabeck Conference Center. Cost is \$400 per term, which covers costs of retreats, books and presenters. Scholarships available, so fees shouldn't be a barrier.

Application materials are due August 15, 2023.
