

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR LYNNE...

This fall we will begin using a new schedule for our worship readings. It is called the Narrative Lectionary and comes out of Luther Seminary. Here is their quick synopsis:



The Narrative Lectionary is a four-year cycle of readings. On the Sundays from September through May each year the texts follow the sweep of the biblical story, from Creation through the early Christian church.

The texts show the breadth and variety of voices within Scripture. They invite people to hear the stories of Abraham and Sarah, Moses and the prophets, Jesus, and Paul. Listening to the many different voices within Scripture enriches preaching and the life of faith.

The readings come from the Old Testament in the fall. We will read key stories from Genesis, Exodus, and other historical writings. During the weeks of Advent, we will hear from the prophets that lead us to the birth of Christ. After Christmas, we move into the gospel according to Mark and will work our way through that gospel chronologically through Easter. Then, through the Easter season to Pentecost we will hear stories from the Acts of the Apostles and Paul's first letter to the Corinthians.

One of the benefits to the Narrative Lectionary is the continuity of stories heard in the order they appear in the Bible. Additionally, our children will be learning these stories at their developmental level and, hopefully, connect with them in worship. For the most part, our Sunday services will follow the same liturgical format of Gather, Word, Meal, and Sending that frames our worship together.

The biggest change will be that we will hear just one reading each Sunday. There may be an accompanying Psalm in some seasons, but for the most part we will focus on one passage of scripture, most of which narrate the stories of God's love and passion for the world.

Bethel has been using the 3-year cycle of the Revised Common Lectionary (RCL) for years and years. Our hope in moving to the Narrative Lectionary is that we will hear some parts of scripture that are missed in the RCL which will help us explore the larger sweep of God's story and our place in it.

The Deacons have agreed to try this lectionary for a year. Please give it a chance as we may find we need to make some adjustments. Then, we will welcome your feedback. I pray that God would speak to us in fresh ways and open us up to the fullness of life found in God's Holy Word.






